The Council of Trade Unions of Central Asian Countries (CTUCA) is the only regional trade union association in Central Asia. It was founded on November 10, 2021.

CTUCA is a non-governmental, non-profit organization operating at the international level.

Goals and objectives:

The main objective of the Council is to protect the social, labor, professional, economic, and other legitimate rights and interests of workers, as well as the rights and guarantees of trade union activities.

Key tasks of the organization:

- Promoting international solidarity among trade unions.
- Support for the activities of member federations.
- Mobilization of consolidated action by trade unions in the region, including in crisis situations and natural disasters affecting the lives of workers.
